To Renegades Enthusiasts -

Patrick reached out to me as a 24 year Renegade and CFO by trade to join the BOD as Treasurer in April. A lot has transpired in the intervening months. We went through a vendor selection process to find a wealth management firm that would be the best possible fit for this venture. The Board voted on and contracted with Sullivan & Schlieman LLC based in Alpharetta. You can read all about the firm on their website at: https://www.sswmllc.com/. The firm and its managing partner Andrew Sullivan have both 20 years of experience in wealth management but also in partnering with non-profits to raise money. The partnership has been fruitful and a Board vote led to an investment direction of medium risk with a primary emphasis on domestic based Mutual Funds, not individual stocks. Beside, you will find the great progress to date since the investment account was established in July. My hope & fervent desire to drive this initiative forward is that the balance will be over \$1 million in next year's report. 

The land identification committee was established to identify potential sites for the development of permanent facilities benefiting the Atlanta Renegades and the entire rugby community in Atlanta. Ideally, the site would accommodate at least two fields and a clubhouse in various configurations. The initial focus would be on the land acquisition with subsequent efforts to add improvements. The committee is fortunate to have several developers with the relevant skills and experience to vet potential sites, negotiate purchase and sale agreements, perform appropriate diligence, procure debt, and close. The search includes sites sufficient to accommodate the rugby facilities and sites that could be developed for multiple uses (Athletic, Multifamily, Hotel, retail). The committee is in place and active, but our success is 100% dependent on the fundraising efforts. Please consider a meaningful contribution to Renegades Forever so we can all stand together on a pitch we call home.




LAND IDENTIFICATION COMMITTEE

Mr. Grass is a managing principal and head of development at Noble Investment Group. He is responsible for leading Noble's Project Management team to execute renovation, redevelopment, and new construction projects. Before joining Noble in 2005, Mr. Grass was executive vice president for the Winter Construction Company. He is a LEED Accredited Professional with the US Green Building Council and has nearly 30 years of development experience. He has personally overseen over 3.0 billion dollars of construction and development. Mr. Grass earned a BS in Construction Management from the Georgia Institute of Technology and is a past board member of the Associated Builders and Contractors of Georgia and the Construction Education Foundation of Georgia. Kevin is a former captain and club president for the Renegades.

Kurt is an accomplished multi-family development and construction professional. His project experience has ranged from high-rise condominiums to garden style apartment developments from the Mid-Atlantic to Southwest regions with over 30 plus years of experience. In 2010, He joined Trey Massey and Pablo Diego to form TRG. As a principal of the firm, he successfully directed the development over 4,000 units with a market value in excess to \$1.1 billion. Prior to TRG, Kurt worked as a Project Manager for Winter Construction, and as a Civil Engineer with Eberly & Associates. He received his bachelor's in civil engineering from the University of Alabama. He, his wife Alison and their four children reside in Marietta, GA. Kurt is a former captain and joined the Renegades in the 1990s.

SCOTT HUTCHISON

Mr. Hutchison has worked in commercial real estate since 2002, specializing in industrial facilities and land. He worked for Tom Wilson and Associates, LLC until he formed the partnership Wilson Hutchison Realty, LLC at the end of 2008. Wilson Hutchison Realty, LLC is a full-service brokerage firm specializing in Landlord Representation, Tenant Representation, Land Acquisition, Site Service Selection, and Lease/Purchase Contract Negotiations. Since embarking on a career in real estate, Mr. Hutchison has successfully negotiated and closed more than 800 commercial and industrial transactions totaling more than \$600 million in value. As of 2022, Scott is actively managing close to 120 properties and 350 tenants. In 2015, Mr. Hutchison founded Southeastern Traffic Supply, LLC to provide a higher standard of service in the traffic control industry throughout Georgia. Mr. Hutchison is also involved with many philanthropies and is on the Board of Directors for several different organizations. Scott joined the Renegades in the early 2000s and has been a tremendous asset to the club ever since.

Chris is a member of the Metro Atlanta Home Builders Association. He is married and has 2 grown children. He became a Renegade in the early 90s and was successful a scrum-half.



DONATING HIGHLY APPRECIATED STOCK

By donating stock, instead of cash, you are able to avoid paying capital gains taxes on the sale of the stock. You are also able to deduct the full fair market value of the stock you donated from your income taxes (up to the overall amount allowed by the IRS.) What if you own a stock that you love, but has a large gain? You can get the benefit of donating the stock, writing it off and then repurchase and resetting the cost basis.

REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTION FROM YOUR IRA

Did you know that you can donate directly from your IRA to a charity? By doing this, you are able to avoid paying income taxes on that withdrawal up to \$100,000 per taxpayer. The funds need to be paid directly from the IRA to the charity. You must be 72 years of age or older to donate this way.

LEGACY GIFTS

Legacy gifts, which are part of estate planning, are donations of money or assets that are planned prior to death. They are meant to help establish an ongoing philanthropic legacy for the giver. If decided, please ensure "Atlanta Renegades Forever Inc." is identified as the beneficiary along with the amount intended.
